Bay 2 Breakers 2010 Survey Results/Summary

- Sent out to NOPNA Networking on Facebook on 05/18/10
- Closed the Survey on 05/20/10
- Responses: 101 of which 53 left comments

Summary:

- The aftermath and **off route** behavior is the main issue
- The race itself went well
- Participant's are out of control, rude and don't respect public or personal property.
- Clean up **on route** went well but could be improved around the panhandle
- Cops weren't doing much to enforce restrictions
- We will never have enough porta potties (perhaps they should double the number in our area)
- Clean up should extend to 4 blocks in each direction of the route in our neighborhood
- Police should patrol outlying area of our neighborhood along the route until 9 or 10 at night (at least 3 or up to 4 blocks off Fell)
- Porta potties should not be placed against anyone's homes
- Recycle bins and trash bins should be placed heavily along the route

Quotes:

"Need more recycle bins and toilets"

"We had a \$400 plant pot pushed over and smashed. Its the behavior of the < 5% who spoil this event."

"Not enough Porto-Johns. Too many people urinating in public in front of our home. No crowd control moving from Hayes to Divis to Fell that the overflow came onto Broderick."

"The race was just fine in the morning. Went for a walk to the Panhandle at 1 PM, and I immediately turned around at Fell and Central because it looked like a scene out of Caligula was brewing.

There was some urinating and vomiting in my side alley post-race by participants this year, but definitely less than last year.

Overall, some good progress but more must be made."

"We spent an hour in the panhandle watching the event. Lots of good fun. A bit of a mess afterwards. But really...what else should we expect?"
